Dear Fellow Professional Athletes

I am reaching-out to my colleagues in the national sports-world (all-sports) encouraging you to join me in taking advantage of a life-changing opportunity for your community organizations, projects or programs.

#### **PC Debit Card Use**

Must be used to expend all funds on your budgeted operations, payroll, services, bills or expansion

- 1. Funds must be used for the operations of your organization.
- 2. Cost: \$3,500 or a Public Endorsement of your support for Student Mental Health, Careers and Community Economic Development.
- 3. Presentation of your project to the network and funders.
- 4. Your Appearance on the PC Sports Show and network podcast shows.
- 5. Host or sponsor a video podcast on the PC Network.
- 6. Must Open an account with the partnering bank managing the fund.
- 7. Must follow the on-boarding and enrollment steps.

#### AVAILABLE FUNDING

(It's Not Free Money, Loans, Grants or Donations, Its life-time and its Never Repaid).

#### \$18,000 to \$120,000 FUNDING

#### **REQUIREMENTS** (annual paid-out monthly)

- 1. Small Business or Nonprofit (single or group)
- 2. Legally setup and operating (or hosted by an approved organization).
- 3. Operation's Budget and the Owner's or CEO's personal budget is required to exceed double the amount you are applying to receive (the business development team will help with this process).
- 4. Must use the PC Media Arts and Business centers.
- 5. Must host or sponsor a Video Podcast on the CBN Network.
- 6. Must make a presentation at one of the Networking Session.

## FOUR MILLION DOLLAR FUND

#### **REQUIREMENTS** (annual or one-time)

- A single organization or a group of partnering organizations must have combined annual spending budgets of four million dollars or more.
- 2. Completed project's annual operating budgets must exceed four million dollars.
- 3. Managing organizations will make a presentation at the hosting industry's networking session.



## TWENTY-FOUR MILLION DOLLAR FUND

#### **REQUIREMENTS** (annual or one-time)

- A single organization or a combined group of partnering organizations must have a combined annual spending budget of twenty-four million dollars.
- 2. The project or program must have an annual operation's budget of twenty-four million dollars or greater.
- 3. Make a presentation at the hosting industry networking session.

#### **NEXT STEPS THE ON-BOARDING PROCESS**

30 to 45 days to complete all steps to begin receiving funds.

#### **STEP ONE**

#### week one

- In-take Video Interview (to discuss your project funding needs and where you are in the process and any potential conflicts or management concerns).
- 2. Sign your NDA, LOI, MOU and
- 3. Pay your Fee or Create an endorsement Video of you endorsing your commitment to Student Mental Health, Careers and Economic Development.
- Present your charity or project and meet the members and funders at one of the Networking Sessions.
- Detail Video interview of your charity or project or funding needs and where you are in the setup, operational or expanding process.

## STEP TWO

### week two

- 1. Learn What & Who is the PC Network
- 2. Ensure You are legally operating. Start any setup or processes needed.
- 3. Complete and submit a Budget to determine funding.
- 4. Meet Corporate Funders.
- 5. Business Branding Materials
- 6. Present your organization to the network
- 7. Film Your Presentation Video
- 8. Podcast Planning (if you have a podcast/broadcast simply send to production team)
- 9. Podcast Video Materials
- 10. Podcast Web-page and Social Media

# **STEP THREE** week three

- 1. Setup & Learn your account & backend
- 2. Plan your 26 episodes season
- 3. Promotions for the first 6 episodes.
- 4. Determine your niche audience
- 5. Your Media Interview Tour
- 6. Send your promotions to your contacts
- 7. Invite your contacts to register
- 8. Organizational Scaling, expansions.

#### START RECEIVING YOUR FUNDS

Funds are rolled out in Steps: \$60k, \$120k, \$2M, \$4M & \$24 Million(if qualified to administrate).

- Start receiving your first: \$5k to \$10k per month through your podcast (30 to 45 days).
- Additional Requirements and proposals are required for the \$2 \$4 Million (building plans, permits, detailed equipment budgets etc.).
